
Welcome to the Summer Research at Nemours application for the Nemours Summer Undergraduate Research Program (NSURP). Please take a few minutes to read the instructions below prior to beginning the application.

We welcome all qualified candidates to apply for our scholarship and embrace all dimensions of diversity including, but not limited to, race, color, marital status, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, age, religion, national origin, (dis)ability, veteran status.

The summer program generally begins at the end of May/first week in June and ends the first Friday of August. Check the NSURP website for specific program dates.

In-person attendance is required throughout the entirety of the 10-week, (40 hrs/wk), full-time program. Personal vacation time is not allowed during the 10 weeks. The program will include both live and virtual components based on the program being held at multiple sites.

The application deadline is January 15 at 11:59 PM EST. Recommenders have until January 31 to submit materials for your application. **Eligibility requirements:**

1. United States citizen or legal permanent resident
 2. Enrollment as an undergraduate student at the time of application
 3. Minimum college GPA of 3.2 (4.0 scale)

*** Students who were selected and participated in past NSURP programs are ineligible to apply ***

Materials Needed – All submissions must be in .pdf, .jpg, or .tif format:

1. Contact information for 2-3 letters of recommendation. Be sure to ask your recommenders first if they are willing to write you a letter. When you submit your application, an email will be automatically generated on your behalf and sent to your

2. Recent transcripts (official or unofficial as long as they are legible)
3. Resume/CV (highlight your past and present research experiences)
4. (Optional): Additional files to share with the selection committee

Please note: It is your responsibility to obtain housing in the area and transportation to your work location and the Nemours location during the program. The program provides a stipend to each student that can be used to offset these expenses.
- Why are you applying to the NSURP? (75 words or less)
- Describe your previous research experiences, if any. (75 words or less)
- When you think of research, what comes to mind? (75 words or less)
- Describe your educational and career goals (75 words or less)
- What motivates you to pursue these educational/career goals? (75 words or less)
- Describe how this summer undergraduate research experience would help you achieve your educational and/or career goals. (75 words or less)
