**First year clinical rotations include 48 weeks of clinical exposure in 2 4 weeks blocks of the following rotations**

- Inpatient general hematology/oncology service (IP H/O)**
- Inpatient transplant and cellular therapy service (IP TCT)**
- Outpatient heme/onc clinic (Clinic)**
- Inpatient consults and procedures (Consults)**
- Blood bank, laboratory, pathology exposure (BBLP)**
- Electives such as proton therapy, palliative care, and radiology (Electives)**

**Second and third years are predominantly research time aside from 12 weeks of inpatient service each year:**
